**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT**  
**Seattle Community College District**  
**and**  
**Hawaii Pacific University**

**I. Introduction**

Based upon a mutual respect for the integrity of parallel academic programs and in an effort to better serve students intending to pursue higher education, Hawaii Pacific University (HPU) and the Seattle Community College district hereby update their articulation agreement effective from this date forward.

**II. Objectives of the Agreement**

1. To facilitate the transition of students from the Seattle Community College district – North, Central and South campuses to Hawaii Pacific University.
2. To encourage academic and administrative coordination between institutions, and the exchange of information.
3. To establish the transfer of credits taken by students who have successfully completed courses in the Seattle Community College system.

**III. Articulation Agreement**

1. Under the provisions of this agreement, students who have completed their courses in the Seattle Community College district with a 2.0 GPA or better will be accepted as transfer students into HPU. Students seeking entry to Nursing, Marine Biology, Oceanography or Environmental Science will need to meet minimum GPA requirements for admissions to those select programs. A course-by-course review of the student's academic records will determine the student's class standing. Only subjects satisfactorily completed with a C or better will be accepted for transfer credits.

2. Students completing an Associate of Arts Transfer program will be recognized as having completed HPU's General Education and Unrestricted Elective requirements, with the exception of those courses that are pre-requisites to major courses.
3. All students entering HPU will be required to take the HPU English Placement Test unless exempt due to transfer credits or appropriate SAT, ACT or TOEFL scores. If a student is found to be deficient in their English skills then developmental course work outside of their program may be required.
  - ~ Students who have completed ENG 101 will be Exempt from the English Placement Test and will receive transfer credit for HPU's WRI 1100, Writing and Critical Analysis course.
4. All students entering HPU will be required to take the HPU Math Placement Test unless exempt due to transfer credits. If a student is found to be deficient in their math skills then developmental course work outside of their program may be required.
  - ~ Students who have completed at least MATH 098 will be exempt from the Math Placement Test and will receive transfer credit for HPU's MATH 1105 and be allowed to register for their next required math course.
5. To receive the maximum number of transfer credits, it would be to the student's advantage to seek a degree program at HPU that is similar to the degree program that was studied at their Seattle Community College campus, however, this does not preclude students from changing their field of study.
6. Students wishing to following a prescribed program without obtaining an Associate of Arts degree, or wishing to incorporate required HPU lower division course requirements for specific programs, may follow the course listing attached for the following majors: Business Administration (all majors), Computer Science, and Nursing.

#### **IV Promotion of the Agreement**

1. Hawaii Pacific University authorizes the Seattle Community College campuses and district office to advertise and disseminate the terms of this agreement to their students in their college literature.
2. Hawaii Pacific University will provide educational materials on HPU in the form of applications, posters, brochures, CD ROM, Video, etc., upon request from Seattle Community College District staff.

#### **V. Review, Continuation and Termination of the Agreement**

1. This agreement shall be reviewed when deemed necessary by either party and revised as appropriate due to curriculum or admission changes at either institution.
2. This agreement shall remain in force until either institution makes a decision to terminate it. It is agreed that if terminated, no additional students will be admitted to the program, but Hawaii Pacific University will honor the terms of the agreement until students already admitted are given the opportunity to complete the program in a timely manner.
