



Articulation Agreement between
Seattle Community College District
And
Indiana University South Bend

This document is a statement of the formal articulation arrangements for collaboration between Seattle Community College District (SCCD) and Indiana University South Bend (IU South Bend). SCCD consists of North Seattle Community College, South Seattle Community College, and Seattle Central Community College.

The purpose of the agreement is to define a smooth transfer process for SCCD students to complete their baccalaureate degree at Indiana University South Bend and outlines transfer requirements, provisions, and related advertising considerations.

1. Upon completion of the Associate of Arts degree (A.A.), the Associate of Science (A.S.), or the Associate in Applied Science-Transfer degree at the Seattle Community Colleges, students will be accepted by Indiana University South Bend (IU South Bend) at junior status with 90 transferable SCCD quarter credits equivalent to 60 IU South Bend semester credits (grades of C or higher).
2. Transferring students must have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or C and a grade of C or better in each transferable course. Courses numbered lower than 100-level are not included in this transfer agreement.
3. International students who complete ENG 101 and ENG 102 with a grade of 2.0 or higher will have met the English proficiency requirements of Indiana University South Bend, and will not need to submit separate proof of English proficiency at the time of application.
4. Transferring students must submit the following admission-related documents:
 - Official SCCD transcript and complete academic records for all other post-secondary coursework.
 - Application for admission with application fee


International students will also need to submit the following:


- Evidence of financial support for at least one year of study at IU South Bend.
- Copies of their immigration documents, i.e., passport identification page(s), I-20, student visa, and I-94 card.

5. SCCD and Indiana University South Bend may choose to work cooperatively in developing promotional materials outlining the details of the transfer agreement.

This agreement will remain in effect until a mutually agreed-upon change is deemed necessary. This agreement may be terminated by either SCCD or IU South Bend with appropriate written notification. A twelve month notice shall be required if either institution decides to terminate the agreement.


This agreement shall become valid when it is signed by each representative of the SCCD and IU South Bend.


